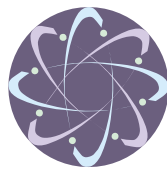


#### LOCATION:
