CSCT Events for 2000-2001:

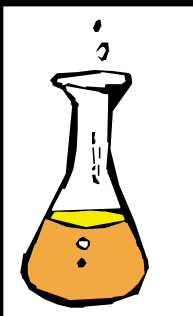

5. Again the CSCT donated \$3000.00 to the Polymer Department of DePaul University which offers a Master's program in polymer chemistry & coatings technology. This donation was matched by DePaul University.
6. Our March 2001 meeting was designated "Education Night" and brought out our highest attendance in over 3 years. Ninety people heard Dr. Greg Kharas (DePaul Univ.) and Bruce Johnson (EPS, Inc.) discuss current polymer research projects at DePaul and coating careers in the greater Chicagoland area, respectively.
