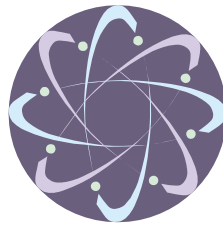

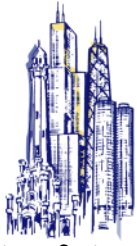
B. Merit Scholarship
