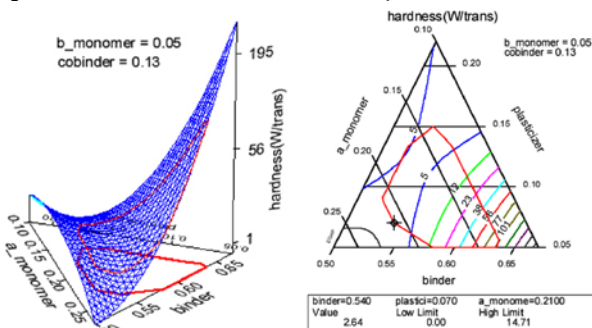
“Design of Experimentation Optimizing Process” • Tom Donnelly - Peak Process, LLC

Tom Donnelly, Ph.D. has been a trainer and consultant with Peak Process, LLC for 3 years. For the previous 12 years he was the Technical Director for ECHIP, Inc., a leading software vendor in the field of response-surface experimental design. He has taught over 150 short courses on Design of Experiments (DOE) strategy and is teaching the second half of the seminar “DOE in The Plastics Industry” at Vinyltec 2002 September 30th. The more than 2000 engineers, scientists, technicians, & managers in these courses came from hundreds of manufacturers and a wide variety of industries. Tom has gone on-site to teach courses at 38 different makers of computers, semiconductors, disk drives, ink jet printers, sensors, automotive components, pharmaceuticals, medical products, cosmetics, plastics, cables, adhesives, sealants, ceramics, and food products.

“**W**hat are the processing conditions required to best meet all the performance goals for this product? What settings will yield lower costs or generate reduced variability for this product?” Whether you are in manufacturing or R&D, or technical support or sales, who wouldn't want to be able to answer these questions? If a customer or management changed their minds and asked, “What if we want to meet these goals instead...?”, who wouldn't want to respond immediately with a clear answer regarding the trade-offs that would need to be made?

Answers to questions like these can easily be provided by using a tool that generates the fewest experimental trials to be run, so that when the collected data are analyzed “interactive pictures” called response surfaces and contour plots are created that makes the simultaneous optimization of multiple product characteristics very easy. The name of this powerful tool is the Response-Surface Method (RSM) - and it has been around for 50 years! Now it does require desktop computing to make the tool accessible - but we've had that capability for 20 years! This talk will discuss the many advantages of using RSM of Design of Experiments (DOE) to quickly get “pictures” of the process that accurately predict performance as a function of many control variables - including plastic, rubber, ink, or paint formulation (mixture) factors.

Examples of a 3-D response surface (left) and a 2-D contour plot (right) for a plastic formulation consisting of 5 components are to the right.

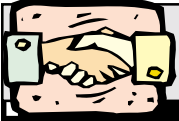

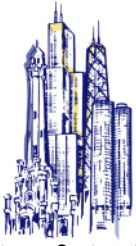
