Lead Free Pigmentation of Paints: Possibilities and Limitations

Since the early 1970's, the paint industry is looking into ways to replace lead based pigments due to environmental and toxicological regulations. Paint waste containing lead based pigments is considered hazardous and the disposal can be very expensive.

The decorative coatings market has made the most significant progress in this area. Today, all decorative coatings are colored with lead free pigments in most industrialized nations. In the industrial coatings sector, the progress has been relatively slow. This can be attributed partly to the technical reasons, and also to the relatively high pigment cost for lead free formulations.

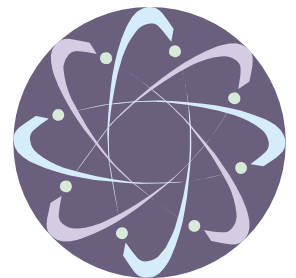
This presentation is a comprehensive overview of possibilities and limitations of organic (lead free) pigments as replacement for lead based pigments. Important issues such as opacity, chroma, viscosity, and chemical fastness will also be discussed.

Speaker Biography; Dr. Romesh Kumar

Dr. Romesh Kumar is Technical Manager – Coatings in the Pigments Business Unit of Clariant Corporation. He specializes in pigments for coatings, color-instrumentation and other aspects of pigment applications.

He attended Laurentian University and Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, where he obtained his Doctorate in Color Science. He is a member of the Inter Society Color Council, Federation of Societies of Coatings Technology, and ASTM. In 2002, he received Nickerson Award from ISCC.

He has made several presentations on color pigments at both national and international meetings.

Letter From your CSCT President

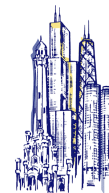
I would like to thank the people from the Society who Volunteered their Time and Work Effort to ensure the success of ICE 2004 that was in McCormick Place North, Chicago.

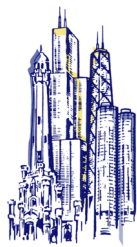
