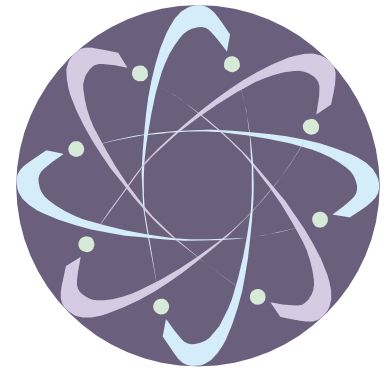

The Effect of TiO₂ Dispersion and Entrapped Air on the Opacity of Alkyd and Acrylic Paints

Paul Dietz - Huntsman Tioxide

The talk examines the issues, problems and possibilities that the paint formulator is likely to experience when using acrylic and alkyd emulsions for high gloss trim paints and how the optical performance of these paints can be linked with air entrapment as well as the utilisation of TiO₂ pigment.

Paul Dietz of Huntsman Tioxide is currently working as the Group Technical Service Manager for Coatings and Inks based in Billingham England, Paul joined Huntsman Pigments in 1986, initially working in Research and Development experimenting with new and novel products for coatings. A graduate in Chemistry from the University of Teesside, since 1998 Paul has worked in Huntsman Pigments Group Technical Service Department. Paul is also a Fellow of the Oil and Colour Chemists Association and a Member of the Chartered Management Institute.

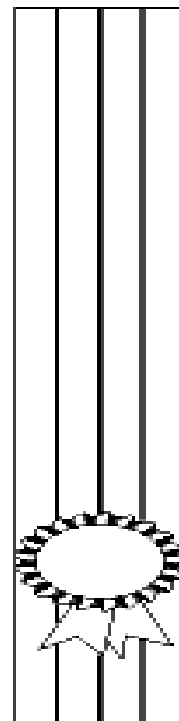
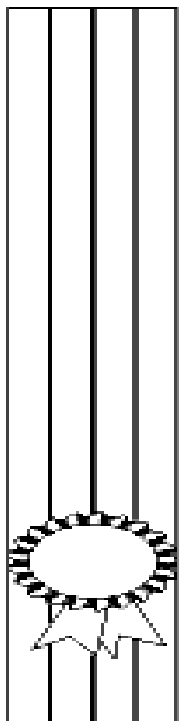

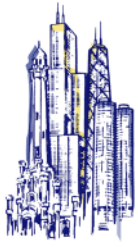
