

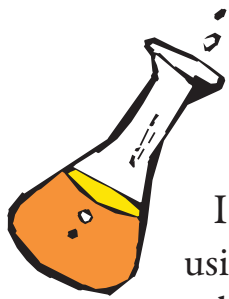

Solar Infrared Reflective Pigments



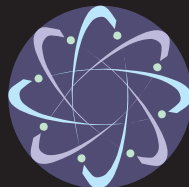
A new pigment technology is being introduced that possesses the ability to reflect radiation in the infrared portion of the solar spectrum. This presentation will discuss this new technology, show the value of using these pigments to provide energy saving and solar heat reflective coatings, discuss the history of solar IR reflective pigments, discuss how they work and show the features and benefits of using this technology. In addition, a review of the markets where these pigments are used and the effect these pigments have in meeting “Energy Star” requirements for various applications will be discussed.

Kenneth Loye is currently Market Development Manager for Ferro Corporation Performance Pigments Division in Cleveland, Ohio. Ken’s background has been in the industrial coatings markets holding various technical, sales and marketing positions during his career. He is the author of a patent for “Simulated Weathered Copper for Coatings”. Ken started at Glidden paint Company in Cleveland in 1969 developing synthetic resins for industrial coatings, then moved on to gain experience in appliance finishes, Gelcoats, General industrial Coatings, and Coil coatings. From Glidden, he then transitioned into marketing of organic pigments for industrial applications, finally joining Ferro in 1999, marketing and selling CICP (Complex Inorganic Color Pigments) for Industrial Coatings applications. He is here today to discuss a new technology - Pigments that reflect Solar Infrared heat.

The Federation of Societies for Coatings Technology has announced the slate of candidates for the three available positions on the 2007 FSCT Board of Directors. Dr. Fritz Walker, Chair of the FSCT Nominating Committee, has noted that three candidates were selected by the Committee, and two additional candidates were submitted by individual member petition.

The Nominees who are elected will each serve three-year terms of office. They will join President Rose Ann Ryntz and Vice President Yasmin Sayed-Sweet, as well as six additional Board members, who were elected in 2006.

NATU C. PATEL has held the position of technical manager of Ace Hardware's Paint Division, Matteson, IL, since 1985. Previously, he was employed as a chemist with Standard T Chemicals and Enterprise Companies. Involved in the coatings industry for 31 years, he received a B.S. Degree in Chemistry and an M.S. Degree in Organic Chemistry from Gujarat University in India..

A member of the Chicago Society (CSCT) since 1979, Mr. Patel served as President in 1995, and has been a member of numerous committees with the Society. He was the recipient of the Society's Outstanding Service Award in 1998 and the Award of Excellence for the growth of CSCT in 2002. He has been a member of the FSCT Board of Directors since 2002. Active on the NPCA AIM Steering Committee since 1998, Mr. Patel is also a member of SSPC and the Chicago Paint & Coatings Association.

******Elections by the general membership will be held in December 2006. Voting will primarily take place electronically through the FSCT web site (www.coatingstech.org). Members who require paper ballots are requested to contact FSCT Headquarters.******

2. Educator ~~and Student~~ Membership:

Any college or high school educator ~~or any college student that is on~~ employed on a full time basis shall be eligible for "Educator" ~~or "Student Membership"~~. But, such membership shall terminate three months after the individual ceases to qualify as "Educator" ~~or "Student"~~ member, both the dues and the rights and privileges of Educator ~~and Student Members~~ shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

3. Student Membership:

Any individual who is a full time student, registered in any educational institution of recognized standing in a course of study in chemistry, engineering, physics or other physical sciences leading to a degree.

4. Retired Membership:

Any "Full Member" or "Educator Member" shall be eligible for "Retired" membership when he or she is no longer considered a permanent employee in the protective and decorative coatings, printing ink industries, or related teaching institutions.

5. Society Honorary Membership:

Any "Full", "Educator", or "Retired" member who has rendered significant service to the Chicago Society shall be eligible for Society Honorary Membership.

6. Federation Honorary Membership:

Eligibility for Federation Honorary Membership shall be subject to the By-laws and Standing Rules of the Federation.

B. Executive Committee

The Executive Committee shall consist of the Officers, the two most recent eligible Past-Presidents, ~~the Society Representative~~ Society Liaison, and two "At Large Membership Representatives". If a CSCT member is elected as a FSCT Director, the CSCT Executive Committee may choose to appoint the FSCT Director to serve as a voting member of the CSCT Board for the full term of his or her office. This appointment shall be made by a majority vote of the Executive Committee.

1. The duties of the Executive Committee shall be to:

- a. Act with the President in establishing and executing the policies and administering the affairs of the Society.
- b. Fill vacancies occurring in the Executive Committee, except those of the President ~~and of the Society Representative~~ and of the FSCT Director

~~IV. Society Representative~~ FSCT Director

A. Election and Term of the FSCT Director

~~The "Full Members" shall elect a Society Representative who shall be a "Full Members" of the Society and must also be a "Full Members" of the FSCT. The elected "Society Representative" shall serve for a term of three years, beginning at the close of the Annual Meeting of the Federation in the year of the election:~~

The Executive Committee, if so inclined, may nominate a Full Member, to run for FSCT Director. The nominee must be a Full Member of both the FSCT and a member of the CSCT. Only Full Members in the FSCT shall elect a FSCT Director.

~~C. If the office of Society Representative becomes vacant, then a new Society representative shall be elected to a three-year term at the next Annual Meeting of the Society.~~

~~D. Alternate Society Representative:~~

- ~~1. The Alternate Society Representative shall be appointed and accredited according the Standing Rules of the Society and the Standing Rules of the Federation:~~
- ~~2. During a vacancy in the office of Society Representative, or otherwise in the absence of the Society Representative, the Alternate Society Representative shall perform all of the functions of the Society Representative according the Standing Rules of the Society and the Standing Rules of the Federation:~~

V. Society Liaison

1. The President of the CSCT shall appoint with the Executive Committee's approval a Society Liaison Representative. The Society Liaison Representative must be a member of the FSCT and CSCT. The Society Liaison shall represent the CSCT at all necessary council meetings and report back to the Executive Committee on issues concerning the CSCT and other Constituent Societies.

2. If the appointed Society Liaison Representative is unable to fill his or her duties or the office becomes vacant, then the Second Past President of the current executive board shall assume the duties of the Society Liaison Representative by President appointment with the approval of the Executive Committee. If the second past president is unable to assume the duties of the Society Liaison Representative, then the CSCT President with approval of the Executive committee shall appoint a new Society Liaison Representative.
