Scheduled speaker is Sean Nuenfeldt, Industrial Chemist, Hallstar and the topic is:

Reduced Fusion Temperature of PVC Plastisols with Ester Plasticizers

With a global drive for higher efficiency and lower energy consumption, PVC Plastisol formulators are being tasked with designing new products for low bake systems. To accomplish this, plastisols must be developed with lower gelation and fusion temperatures. Along with these new challenges, formulators must also ensure plasticizer permanence, migration and weight loss are also factored in.

Sean Neuenfeldt has been working as a chemist in the coating industry since 2013. He received his bachelor of science in biochemistry from Michigan State and his masters of science in Chemistry from Oakland University. Sean spent two years at Axalta Coating Systems as Honda's OEM plant support chemist and continued his career with Hallstar as part of the industrial polymer modifiers team. He is currently lives in Chicago as Hallstar's lead technical chemist for the Exxate product line

Abstract: Acetate esters are used when surface perfection is a must. With ultra-low moisture absorption and excellent solvent release from the film, acetate esters are designed to reduce blistering and corrosion. These products have tightly defined chain lengths that provide clearly defined evaporation rates for a controlled release, limiting surface imperfections. Additionally, these can be used as polymerization solvents as esters are highly efficient at solvating polymers and allow formulators to use significantly less initiator compared with other standard solvents.
