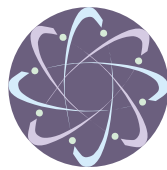

As new paint systems evolve driven by environmental regulations, consumer demands for improved performance, etc., the need for new and better pigments requires

continued innovation to meet changing market expectations. However, finding a totally new pigment class is a rare event. Manipulation of pigment crystal form, particle size and shape, surface treatment, and formation of solid solutions are the research focus shaping the colored pigment into the desired market requirements. The evolution of two important pigment classes and some of the tools available to the pigment chemist for color and performance will be discussed.



Frank Hilfiker is the Director of Coatings Technical Service at Ciba. He has a Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry and has spent the last 30 years in various positions directed toward pigments and dyes.


