

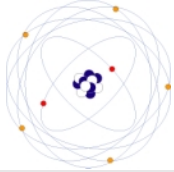

This presentation will be somewhat general in nature to inform the group on the subject of the aerospace coatings business subset of the overall coatings area. Part of the discussion will center on the business aspects of this field; the customers, size and growth of the business, business trends and expectations, and the companies in the coatings field who participate. The other area to be discussed will focus on the technical aspects of the market; general technical aspects, product needs and requirements, specific testing for aerospace products, and the direction of R&D programs to meet the existing and future needs for aircraft structural integrity.

Aerospace is somewhat unique in that two principal companies, Airbus and Boeing, effectively control the specifications for the entire industry, and also drive the need for differences in technology development between Europe and North America. This presents challenges in terms of designing and directing global R&D programs and this aspect will also be a topic of the presentation.

The Federation, "FSCT", has made some recent changes that have a direct impact on our local "CSCT" society. Please take note; the "FSCT" will go to a direct billing for membership renewals. The amount of those dues will be \$110; up from \$65 last year. It is important to know that the \$110 bill consists of \$80 for the FSCT and \$30 for CSCT. Last year the breakdown was \$40 for FSCT and \$25 for CSCT.

The CSCT board felt it is important to offer our members another option. We will offer another level of membership, which we have called "CSCT Local". The annual dues for the "CSCT Local" membership will be \$30 for Full Members and \$15 for Retired and Students.

You will have to make a decision as to which membership option to choose.

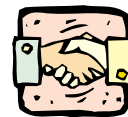

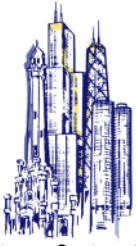

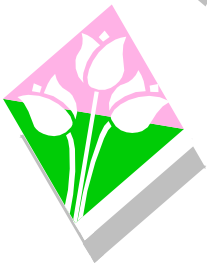
