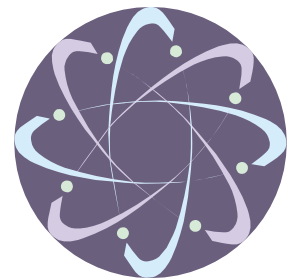
#### **Alkyd Resins for High Solids and Water Reducible Applications**

Increasingly stringent environmental regulations have continued to drive paint technology since the mid-70's. As lower VOC limits have been enacted by the U.S. EPA, conventional alkyds and polyesters have been replaced by several compliant technologies, including high solids solventborne, waterborne, powder coating, and U.V. cure. This presentation will explore three of these options: High solids solventborne, amine neutralized (water reducible) alkyds and polyesters, and low VOC latex polymers. Choice of compliant technology, formulation and troubleshooting will be discussed.

Guy Lopez is a graduate of Lake Forest College with a B.A. in Environmental Studies. He has more than twenty years of experience formulating, servicing and selling industrial coatings in a wide variety of end-use applications and technologies. 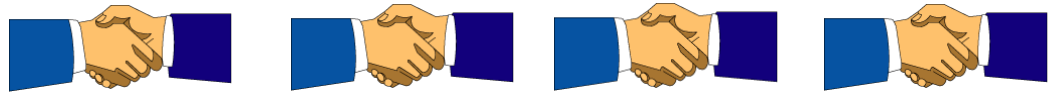

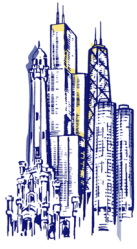
