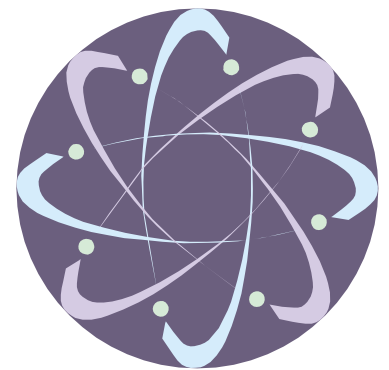

DuPont Economic Forecast For The Coatings Industry

Robert Fry - DuPont

Robert Fry is Senior Associate Economist at DuPont, a position he has held since November 1994. Robert began his DuPont career with Conoco in 1984, moved to the DuPont Economist's Office in 1987, and was a fixed income analyst for DuPont's pension fund in 1993 and 1994. In his current role, Robert analyzes and forecasts the global economy and its impact on DuPont, and assists DuPont businesses with interpreting economic data and using it to forecast DuPont performance. He speaks frequently to customers, trade associations, and DuPont business teams and is the author of *Current Business Developments*, a monthly newsletter. Robert and his colleague, Corporate Economist Bob Shrouds, have been recognized for their forecasting prowess by *The Wall Street Journal*, *USA Today*, and Bloomberg. Robert holds a Bachelor's degree from Ohio University and a Master's and Ph.D. from Harvard University.

In his presentation, Robert will discuss the global economic outlook for 2006, which emphasis on sectors of interest to the U.S. coatings industry. The presentation will cover GDP, industrial production, housing starts, vehicle sales and production, inflation, and interest rates.

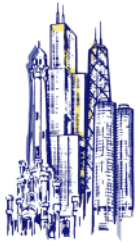
