“Selection of Reactive Diluents for High Performance Epoxy Coatings”

Epoxy resins used in 2-pack coatings are viscous liquids or solids, so viscosity reduction is always an issue formulators must address. Solvents can be used, but the associated VOC is undesirable. Reactive diluents are commonly used to decrease viscosity without increasing VOC. However, these materials can adversely affect other performance characteristics. This presentation covers trade-offs formulators must consider when formulating the most widely used reactive diluents in high performance epoxy coatings.

Mike Watkins is a polymer chemist with over 37 years of experience developing high performance industrial coatings for a number of companies, including Sherwin-Williams, Battelle Columbus Laboratories, Shell Chemical Company, and Hexion Specialty Chemicals. Mike spent 25 years in the epoxy business designing resins, curing agents, modifiers, and formulated systems. During that time, he helped epoxy formulators around the world to develop many new products and processes. He founded Cypress Chemical Consulting, Inc. to continue his work with epoxies and industrial coatings.

“Optimizing Vinyl Acetate Ethylene Based Enamels Using Design of Experiments: A Formulator’s Perspective”

Titanium Dioxide is currently in a supply shortage position which is expected to worsen over the coming years. As a result there is renewed vigor in using extender pigments to stretch available material. Selection and use of extender pigment is only successful if the correct material is identified. The presentation will look at the basis for choice which initially is formulation position relative to CPVC. For formulations above CPVC structured Pigment compared to Conventional Calcined clay offers superior results, while this can also be supplemented by judicious selection of Calcium carbonate. Examples will show basic principles of use. For formulation below CPVC the options are more limited and rely on developing improved spacing of the TiO₂ to maximize its properties. New modified ultrafine Calcium Carbonates are available which combine particle size and improved dispersibility allowing them to act as effective TiO₂ spacers and also maintain a neutral white color. Specific products are available for both solvent and water based systems.

Rick Caldwell is a research associate and project leader for the development of architectural coatings latexes for Forbo Bonding Systems Synthetic Polymers Group, focusing on introducing new vinyl acetate ethylene latexes for “green” architectural coatings. Rick has worked in the architectural coatings industry for over 25 years, formulating with numerous binder and additive technologies. Rick previously held positions at Reichhold Inc., NL Chemicals (Elementis), and M.A.Bruder & Sons (Sherwin-Williams). He has a BS degree in Chemistry from West Chester University, PA.
